EMERGENCY FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE *(YOU NEVER HAVE TO PAY BACK!)*

Two Ten can help get you and your family back on track by providing short-term, financial support with expenses such as:

- Rent or mortgage payments
- Utility bills
- Car repairs or payments
- Funeral expenses
- Disaster relief
- Emergency assistance for food, clothing, temporary housing, and more

COUNSELING SERVICES AND COMMUNITY RESOURCES

Through our partnership with FEI Behavioral Health, Inc., Two Ten also offers footwear families access to:

- Crisis intervention via confidential phone support with a licensed social worker 24/7, 365 days/year
- Credit and debt counseling
- Legal resources
- Elderly, dependent and child care resources
- Educational resources

HIGHER EDUCATION AND DESIGN SCHOLARSHIPS

Two Ten offers the following scholarships to eligible footwear employees and their families:

- Classic higher education scholarships, undergraduate and design scholarships renewable for up to 4 years, and
- Industry education scholarships, certificate and intensive-program scholarships aimed to further employees' careers in the industry.

ELIGIBILITY FOR SERVICES

CLIENT MUST WORK IN THE FOOTWEAR AND/OR ALLIED INDUSTRIES:

- For previous two (2) consecutive years minimum, or
- For one (1) year minimum for crisis relief cases, or
- For at least two (2) years total, with the last day of industry employment within one year of application date.

If you have previously received financial assistance from Two Ten in the past 24 months, you are not eligible for additional assistance. However, emergency or crisis situations will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis. All members of the footwear community are eligible for counseling and information and referral services regardless of length of employment.
